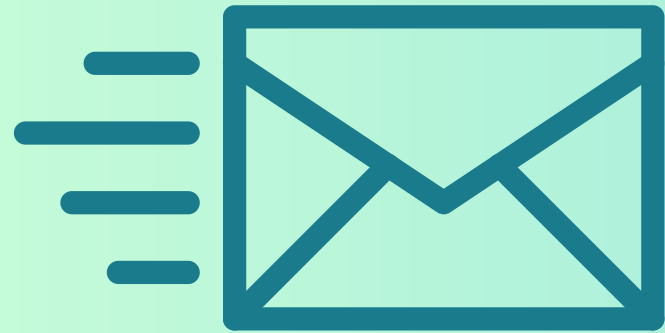

 - Capacity building for engagement & promoting engagement

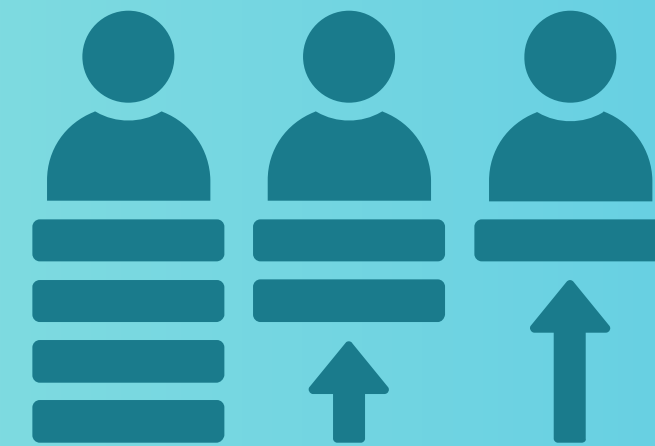

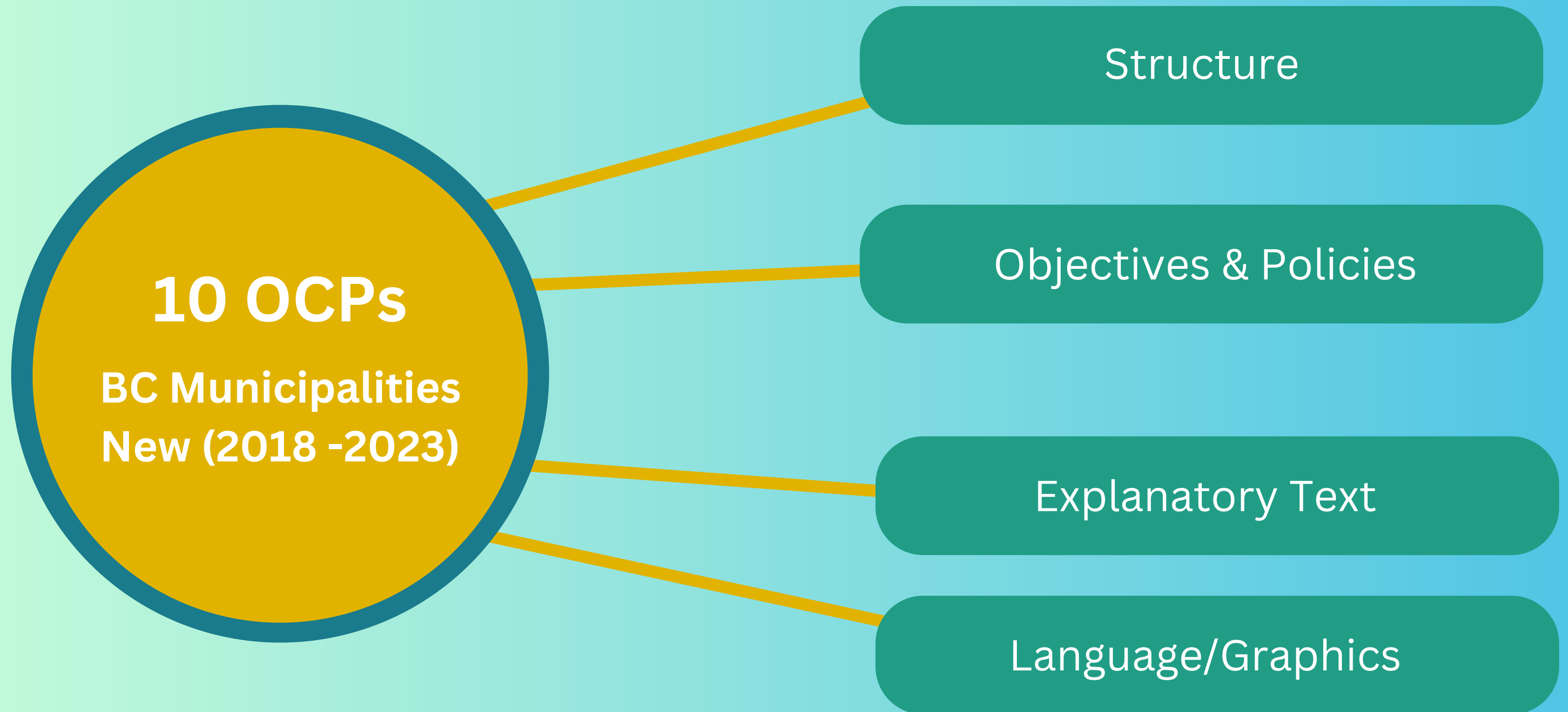


Policy Review Update
